Successfully complete the **transition course**\* and receive 13 academic credits toward the BS in Nursing at Howard University: Lifespan Health Promotion & Assessment (4 credits), Therapeutic Interventions (4 credits), Orientation to Nursing 2 credits), and Theoretical Foundation (3 credits)

The co-requisites may conveniently be taken during the same semester as the above transition course.

**BSN Requirements**

- Minimum degree requirement: 125 credits
- A 2.5 CGPA is required to start junior level courses.
- Last 30 credits must be completed at Howard University.

Upon completion of the transition course and all pre-requisites, the BSN program may be completed in a minimum of three semesters of full-time study.

\* The LPN to RN transition course is a 125-contact-hour course to validate prior LPN knowledge and to promote new knowledge needed for advancement directly into the second semester of nursing clinical courses.
